


due to a storm.

Storm surge can be more dangerous than the hurricane itself.



Categories 4 & 5: Catastrophic damage will occur; homes can be damaged or destroyed; power outages will last for weeks, possibly months; mandatory evacuation likely in some areas

Turn Around, Don't Drown

Never drive through standing water. Just 12 inches of water

can sweep a car away.
